VETO OF RESOLUTION NO. 12, CURRENT SERIES, OF THE HONORABLE MUNZ CIPAL BOARD OF ORMOC CITY PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT 179

The undersigned by virtue of and pursuant to Art. 3, Sec. 14, Republic Act No. 179, vetoes Rec. No. 12, current series, of the Honorable Municipal Board of Ormoc City, with the reasons herewer stated:

a.- The members of the Muricipal Board are blected at large and as such lave the powers, duties as well as responsibilities co-extensive with the City and not for any particular district by the nature of their respective positions;

b.- The members of not represent loarticular district but the city of Oract. Concentration of the efforts of one countilor for a
particular district where he is to be assigned
will give the to rule as competitions and jealousiss in the application of improvements to
their respective district. It is not also a
sound administrative policy that a councilor
was a his hands in case of a failure of another
in the administration of a municipal district
into a it would be unmanly for him to claim
the love of the success of another councilor;
whereas, if they are councilors at large they
will feel that they owe their allegiance and
love to any particular district but to the
whole city;

c.- Ever since the enactment of the Charter, it has been a long established precedent that a councilor does not represent a particular district like the practice followed in other cities hin the Philippines. While it is true that in municipalities there are municipal districts, a city has a distinct personality with a function entirely different from a municipality;

d. Resolution No. 12 is also discriminatory. The vice Mayor is a ranking member of the Board, yet it failed to state that a certain municipal district will be placed under him. No reason is stated in the Resolution of this unjust exclusion and discimination against the Vice Mayor.
