RESOLUTION NO. 25

WHEREAS, the Municipal Board, Ormoc City, in its regular session held on January 12, 1952, passed resolution number 25, reverting the appropriation for the salary of the Assistant City Attorney to the General Fund of Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Acting City Mayor and Vice Mayor Marcelo D. Bandalan, vetoed said resolution for reasons stated in the veto; dated January 23, 1952;

WHEREAS, Councilor Teotimo Ocubillo strongly suggested to the Honorable Body to over-ride the Veto of the Acting City Mayor and Vice Mayor Marcelo D. Bandalan on the ground that the city is facing a probable deficit for the current fiscal year 1951-1952;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Teotimo Ocubillo, seconded by Councilor Jorge S. Tan,

BE IT RESOLVED as is hereby resolved to override the veto of the Honorable Acting City Mayor and Vice Mayor Marcelo D. Bandalan of Resolution No. 25, c.s. of the Municipal Board, Ormoc City;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the Honorable Executive Secretary, Malacañan Palace, Manila; the Hon. Secretary of Finance, Manila, the City Mayor, Ormoc City; City Treasurer, Ormoc City; City Auditor, Ormoc City and the City Attorney, Ormoc City.

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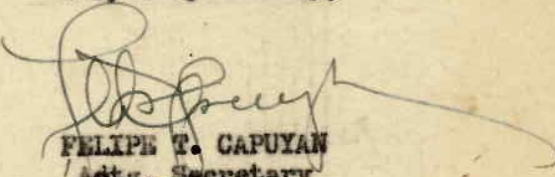
