RESOLUTION NO. 45

Letter of the City Health Officer, Ormoc City, dated
January 2, 1952, hereunder quoted verbatim as follows:

(Thru His Honor, the City Mayor)
Ormoc City

Gentlemen:

There has been deposited in the office of the City Treasurer the sum of ₱3,500.00 previously appropriated for the construction of City Hospital and ₱396.38 still unappropriated allotment from the Charity Sweepstakes for 1948 and 1949. Inasmuch as the amounts are too small to construct a Hospital taking into consideration the high cost of materials, this office believes, that his reversion into the establishment of a city laboratory is more advantageous and useful to the inhabitants. Our public water supply, the ice-drop, sputum, pus, blood test, malaria, yaws, schistosomiasis, urine analysis, stool examination for intestinal parasites and the determination of carrier from water-borne diseases among food handlers.

The investigation of the above enumerated diseases are the most important steps in the determination of public health. Hence, out of 700 stool specimen among school children submitted to the UNICEF Laboratory it was found that 95% are suffering from ascaris lumbricoides and 35% are harboring hookworm.

A tentative appropriation is hereby recommended for your consideration.

1. Additional building 8 m. x 6 m. adjacent to the main office..... ₱ 746.38
 2. Venetian blind..... 150.00
 3. Purchase of Laboratory Supplies and materials... 3,000.00
- Total..... ₱ 3,896.38

Believing that this request has the intention to improve the health of the inhabitants your good office will not hesitate to extend the humanitarian support.
