RESOLUTION NO. 65

WHEREAS, Bill No. 2195 creating the Municipality of Tugbong, presented by Congressman Domingo Veloso, is now under consideration in Congress;

WHEREAS, said Bill proposed to take the barrios of Tugbong, Montealegre, Tagaytay, Libonigao, Maghaling, Montevilla and Masarayao, of the Municipality of Kananga and the barrios of Manlilinae, Montorico, Maticaa and San Ignacio of Ormoc City, making the Municipality of Kananga unable to exist as a Municipality because its size will be greatly reduced to compose only the Kananga proper, Rizal, Visares and Loday;

WHEREAS, the creation of the new Municipality of Tugbong would leave the Municipality of Kananga only three barrios, Rizal, Visares and Loday which would mean the abolition of the Municipality of Kananga;

WHEREAS, said Bill will be prejudicial to the City of Ormoc because it will reduce considerably the jurisdiction of Ormoc City and its revenues;

WHEREAS, said Bill will be prejudicial to the government because it will incur additional expenses, thus adding to the overburdened budget of our government;

WHEREAS, Tugbong is only three kilometers from Kananga along the road and a distance of one and one-half kilometers directly from Kananga and that there is no necessity of the creation of such municipality in so short a distance from a newly created municipality;

WHEREAS, the creation of the Municipality of Tugbong as proposed in Bill No. 2195 has not originated from the desires of the people of Tugbong, nor of Kananga, nor of Ormoc, all of which are directly affected by such bill;

WHEREAS, there exists no problem of inadequate police protection of these barrios proposed to consist the Municipality of Tugbong as motivated in the proposed bill presented, and if such problem ever exists, it is but temporary in nature;

WHEREAS, it will be unfair to proceed to create the Municipality of Tugbong without consulting the people of Ormoc and Kananga who are directly prejudiced by the provisions of such Bill No. 2195;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Usualde F. Laguitan, seconded by Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to petition the President of the Philippines, Manila; the Senate President, Manila; the Speaker, House of the Representatives, Manila; the Senators and Representatives in the Philippines Congress, Manila; that Bill No. 2195 creating the Municipality of Tugbong be disapproved;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, Malacañan Palace, Manila; the Senate President, Manila; the Speaker, House of the Representatives, Manila; the Hon. City Mayor, Ormoc City; City Treasurer, Ormoc City; City Auditor, Ormoc City.
