RESOLUTION NO. 95

WHEREAS, Mr. Protasio Escorro, City Agronomist of Ormoc City, being present during the deliberation of the Hon. Body in its regular session held on May 24, 1952, informed the Hon. Members of the Board that House Bill No. 1457, creating the Bureau of Agricultural Extension Service has been approved by Congress setting aside One and One-half Million Pesos (P1,500,000) from the counterpart fund of the BOA to be divided into 40% and 40%; 40% to be divided among the number of personnel and 40% to be divided among the number of farms in the whole Philippines, based on the 1937 census;

WHEREAS, Mr. Escorro further informed the Honl. Body that this aid will be in a form of implements such as; soil testers, farm levels and other farm implements;

WHEREAS, according to Mr. Escorro, under the creation of this Bill No. 1457, chartered cities are not mentioned in the distribution of the counterpart fund;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City to respectfully request the Hon. Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources and the Chairman of the Mutual Security Administration to entitle Ormoc City to that counterpart fund of One and One-half Million Pesos inasmuch as Ormoc City is an agricultural city, having 48 barrios; 52,000 hectares of agricultural land; of 4,510 agricultural farms and having a total population of 78,000;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Teotimo Ocubillo, seconded by Councilor Ifaki Larrazabal;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to respectfully request the Hon. Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources and the Chairman, Mutual Security Administration, Manila, to entitle Ormoc City to the counterpart fund of One and One-half Million Pesos inasmuch as Ormoc City is an agricultural city, having 48 barrios; 52,000 hectares of agricultural land of 4,510 agricultural farms and with a total population of 78,000;

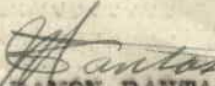

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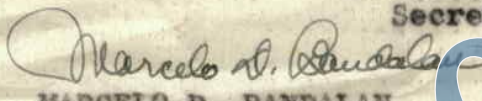
