VETO OF RESOLUTION NO. 104, CURRENT SERIES, OF THE HONORABLE MUNICI-PAL BOARD, ORMOC CITY, IN PUR-SUANCE TO ART. 3, SEC 14, REPUBLIC ACT No. 179

The undersigned, by virtue of Art. 3, Sec. 14, of Republic Act Nol 179, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, hereby vetoes Res. No. 104 of the Honorable Municipal Board, this City, on the following grounds:

1. To temporarily suspend the salaries of all City employees effective July 1, 1952 until the fiscal budget for the fiscal year 1952-1953 is approved by the Honorable Municipal Board, as contemplated in Nes. No. 104 c.s., is undemocratic and high-hadded aside from being unreasonable, impractical and against public policy. In fine, it is unconstitutional, hence this veto.
