RESOLUTION NO. 104

WHEREAS, His Honor, the City Mayor of Ormoc City
has not yet submitted to the Municipal Board the budget
for the fiscal year 1952-53;

WHEREAS, Councilor Esteban C. Conejos suggested to
the Hon. Body that inasmuch as the fiscal budget for the
fiscal year 1952-53 has not yet been submitted by His
Honor, the City Mayor, the salaries of the city employees
of Ormoc City be suspended for the time being until the
budget for the fiscal year 1952-53 be approved by the
Municipal Board;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor
Esteban C. Conejos, seconded by Councilor Iñaki Larrazabal;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to temporarily
suspend the salaries of all city employees effective July
1, 1952 until the fiscal budget for the fiscal year 1952-
1953 is approved by the Municipal Board;

FINALLY RESOLVED, to furnish copy of this resolution
each to the Hon. City Mayor, Ormoc City; City Treasurer,
Ormoc City; City Auditor, Ormoc City; City Attorney, Ormoc
City; City Engineer, Ormoc City; Municipal Judge, Ormoc
City; Chief of Police, Ormoc City and the Fire Chief,
Ormoc City.



VETO OF RESOLUTION NO. 104, CURRENT
SERIES, OF THE HONORABLE MUNICI-
PAL BOARD, ORMOC CITY, IN PUR-
SUANCE TO ART. 3, SEC 14,
REPUBLIC ACT No. 179
- - - -

The undersigned, by virtue of Art. 3, Sec. 14, of
Republic Act No. 179, otherwise known as the Charter of
Ormoc City, hereby vetoes Res. No. 104 of the Honorable
Municipal Board, this City, on the following grounds:

1. To temporarily suspend the salaries of all
City employees effective July 1, 1952 until
the fiscal budget for the fiscal year 1952-
1953 is approved by the Honorable Municipal
Board, as contemplated in Res. No. 104 c.s.,
is undemocratic and high-handed aside from
being unreasonable, impractical and against
public policy. In fine, it is unconstitu-
tional, hence this veto.

day of July, Nineteen Hundred and Fifty-Two, in the
