RESOLUTION NO. 120

WHEREAS, the City Charter of Ormoc provides for the creation of school board for the city the functions of which are provided for in the administrative code same as the functions of school boards in the municipalities;

WHEREAS, the charter provides for the board to compose of six members two of which are women who are interested in the education of the youths of this city;

WHEREAS, the selection of the above members proposed is based upon the following reasons, to wit:

COMMITTEE ON SCHOOLS--They actually present to the board whatever is agreed upon by the school board.

Mrs. Felisa Z. Mejia--She has been a successful public school teacher. Formerly owner and directress of the Ormoc Institute, Social leader and successful in her business enterprises.

Mrs. Rafael Martinez--Has been a successful teacher, dormitory matron, and interested in the education of the young people.

Mr. Flaviano Montesclaros--Has been a Councilor for Twenty One Years and a public school teacher for Twenty Four Years.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board on motion of Councilor Usualdo F. Laguitan seconded by Councilor Teotimo Ocubillo;

BE IT RESOLVED, As is hereby resolved to create the Ormoc City School Board to compose the following;


SECOND VETO OF RES. NO. 120, IN CONJUNCTION
TO RESOLUTION NO. 122, CURRENT SERIES
OF THE HONORABLE MUNICIPAL BOARD
OF ORMOC CITY, PURSUANT TO
REPUBLIC ACT NO. 179

By virtue of the powers vested in me by Sec. 14, Art. III, Republic Act No. 179, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, the undersigned hereby vetoes for the second time Res. No. 120, in conjunction to Res. No. 122, current series, of the Honorable Municipal Board, this City, citing the same grounds contained in the 1st veto of His Honor, the City Mayor, dated the 13th of August, 1952, and the following specific grounds enumerated hereunder as follows:

- 1.- That in the selection of members to be elected by the Division Superintendent of Schools concerned, said official must be given a free hand and that Res. No. 122 hereby vetoed should not limit and advance the names of members to be selected by the Division Superintendent of Schools;
- 2.- That in creating the Ormoc City School Board, which is an Advisory Body to the Committee on Schools of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, the opinion of the Division Superintendent concerned as to the advisability of its creation should be sought first for in ultimate analysis, it is that office which has the initiative to create and dissolve the Ormoc City School Board which is proposed to be created by Res. No. 122 hereby vetoed. (SEC. 920 of the Revised Administrative Code).
- 3.- That no members of the Ormoc City councilor should be elected members of the Ormoc City School Board proposed in said Res. No. 122, current series, as they are ineligible to the position based on apparent incompatibility. It would be indecent, if not too selfish for a councilor to vote for himself as member of the Ormoc City School Board, it appearing that Res. No. 122 aforecited was approved unanimously. The councilors should not give cause for suspicion that the School Board was created for their own selfish interests;
- 4.- That no person who has vested interest in any private educational institution should be elected as member of the Ormoc City School Board which is proposed to be created by Res. No. 122 herein vetoed, because then, the interest of the School Board shall be secondary only to the interest of their own private school;
- 5.- That the members of the Ormoc City School Board proposed to be created in said Res. No. 122 should be free from partisan politics. The City School Board should be composed, not of politicians and members with vested interest in private educational institution, but of men and women highly civic minded and devoted social workers whose interest is mainly for the educational advancement of the City public school.

In view of the foregoing consideration, the undersigned hereby returned to the Honorable Municipal Board, Ormoc City, Res. No. 122, current series, with this veto.
