RESOLUTION NO. 121

WHEREAS, on suggestion of Councilor Usualdo F. Laguitan to allow the previous occupants of the stalls of the market tiendas, Public Market, Ormoc City that were burned to ashes during the great conflagration that occurred on October 4, 1952; to construct temporary shade;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Usualdo F. Laguitan, seconded by Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla;


BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to allow the previous occupants of the market tiendas of the Public Market, Ormoc City to construct a temporary shade for their tiendas;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to reduce the previous rentals to 50% for the first two months from the approval of this resolution and to reduce to 1/3 said rentals after the lapse of two months on condition that at the time the city government constructs the buildings they, (the occupants) will pay for the demolition of their temporary buildings;


RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the Hon. City Mayor, Ormoc City; City Treasurer, Ormoc City; City Auditor, Ormoc City and the Market Superintendent, Ormoc City.
