RESOLUTION NO. 162

WHEREAS, the Municipal Board of Ormoc City in its regular session held on October 4, 1952 passed resolution No. 148, Ordinance No. 10 thereby increasing the loading and transportation fees of pigs loaded at Ormoc City to be transported to other places;

WHEREAS, the Hon. City Mayor pursuant to Article 3, Sec. 14 of Republic Act No. 177, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City vetoed said Resolution No. 148, Ordinance No. 10 for the reasons stated in his veto;

WHEREAS, Councilor Victorino C. Teleron manifested that the cause of the high prices of pork in the public market was due the exportation of pigs from Ormoc City to Manila;

WHEREAS, the Councilor further manifested that his purpose of increasing the loading and transportation fees of pigs is to lessen the exportation of the same for the protection of the interest of the people of Ormoc City;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Victorino C. Teleron seconded by Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla;


BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to override the veto of the Hon. City Mayor;
