RESOLUTION NO. 167

WHEREAS, the City Government has made so many communications to Manila regarding the release of funds for the City of Ormoc as a result of the recent typhoon;

WHEREAS, these communications have not been answered up to now;

WHEREAS, by Executive Order of His Excellency, the President of the Philippines there was released already the necessary public works fund;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Usualdo P. Laguitan, seconded by Councilor Jorge S. Tan;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to create a committee composing of the City Mayor, the City Engineer and two members of the Municipal Board to compose the delegation to go to Manila to make representations to the President of the Philippines for the immediate release of funds needed for the City of Ormoc;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to appropriate the amount of P850.00 for the traveling expenses of the said delegation; P250.00 for the City Mayor; P100.00 for the City Engineer and P500.00 for the two members of the Municipal Board; the same to be taken from the unappropriated balance otherwise not appropriated;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the Hon. City Mayor, Ormoc City; City Treasurer and the City Auditor, Ormoc City and the City Engineer, Ormoc City.
