RESOLUTION NO. 172

WHEREAS, Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla manifested before the Honorable Body that Ormoc City lacks public playgrounds facilities for the improvement of the health of the population;

WHEREAS, like any other chartered cities in the Philippines, Ormoc City ought to have several public playgrounds where the people could recreate and improve their health;

WHEREAS, the city government of Ormoc is not now in a position to defray the expenses for the construction of the same in view of its precarious financial condition;

WHEREAS said Councilor expressed the view that the funds for the purpose may be raised by charging corn and rice mills of Ormoc City a nominal inspection fee of five centavos (P0.05) for every palay and/or corn milled and gasoline stations, one-fourth (1/4) of a centavo for every liter of gasoline sold, the same to be made effective for a period of only three (3) months;

WHEREAS, he further expressed the view that those affected are civic minded and therefore, willing to cooperate in the promotion of the health of the Community;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Teotimo Ocubillo;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to charge corn and rice mills five centavos (P0.05) as nominal inspection fee for every cavan of palay and/or corn milled and one-fourth centavo (1/4) for every liter of gasoline sold by Gasoline stations of Ormoc City, the same to be made effective from December 1, 1952 to February 28, 1953;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the amount raised be appropriated for the construction of parks and grounds;


