NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Iñaki Larrazabal;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to trans-mit to the Hon. Director of Public Works, Manila, the following reasons why a permanent bridge is necessary ofwe the Panalian River:

1. That the Panalian river crosses a highway between Ormoc City and Baybay, Leyte and continuous traffic between the two places is usually obstructed during floods which destroys the temporary bridge.

That the Panalian River is located between Ormoc City proper and the barrio of Ipil where the Ormoc Sugar Central is located and where milling is almost continuous the whole year round; that during milling season there is a continuous hauling of sugar came from Ormoc towards the barrio of Ipil passing the Panalian river, so that a permanent bridge over said river is imperative:
- 3. The construction of the permanent bridge over the Panalian river will mean an increase of revenue both to the Local and National Government.
- 4. The construction of said bridge will promote the commercial intercourse between 0 city vid all the different towns in Eastern and str. Leyt.
