RESOLUTION NO. 64

WHEREAS, inasmuch as the City Festival for this year's annual celebration is drawing near and inasmuch as there are already many side shows constructed on our plaza, the Presiding Officer recommended to the Hon. Body to temporarily suspend the vehicular traffic of some corners of our City Streets;

WHEREAS, Councilor Victorino C. Teleron further suggested to effect the suspension of the vehicular traffic with the exception of Official cars;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board on motion of Councilor Teotimo Ocubillo seconded by Councilor Victorino C. Teleron;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to temporarily suspend the vehicular traffic of corners Bonifacio and Aviles Sts. and San Pedro and Aviles Sts with the exception of official cars;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to request the/Officers of the Police Department, Ormoc City to effect the temporary suspension of vehicular traffic on the two corners aforementioned effective June 27 to July 4, 1953;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, to request said traffic Officers to place signboards on said corners above-mentioned in order to warn the public, thus avoiding accidents.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the City Mayor, Chief of Police, City Treasurer and City Auditor all of Ormoc City.
