RESOLUTION NO. 65

1st Indorsement of the Vice Mayor & Acting City
Mayor dated June 26, 1953 a letter of Mrs. Monica R.
Aguirre hereunder quoted verbatim as follows:

Ormoc City
June 25, 1953

The Hon. Municipal Board
(Thru His Honor, the City Mayor)
Ormoc City

Gentlemen:

This has reference to a resolution of the Mpl.
Board of Ormoc City, numbered 86, series of 1951
re-sales application of Messers. Cesar Samson,
Monico R. Aguirre and Usualdo F. Laguitan of public
lands bordering Anilao River.

The undersigned is the owner of two-thirds
(2/3) of Lots Nos. 1240 & 1241, 1237, including its
extension of 1120 sq. m. & 1239 of Ormoc Cadastre.

As per agreement in open session of the Board
with the applicants concerned, to the effect that
the small portion subject-matter of said sales
application, specifically with respect to that of
Mr. Usualdo F. Laguitan, the Municipal Board offered
no objection to extend 15 meters towards Anilao
river from the titled land of Mr. Usualdo F. Laguitan;
to applicant Mr. Monico R. Aguirre; 15 meters towards
Anilao River from his titled land; and to applicant
Dr. Cesar S. Samson, all that portion covered by
improvement towards Anilao River from his titled
land.

In this connection, I have the honor to inform
the Honorable Body that applicant, Mr. U. F. Laguitan
did not reserve an extension of 15 meters from his
titled land and from the land of the undersigned,
instead he fenced the land adjoining the land of the
undersigned right at its E. L. monuments.

It is therefore requested that the Honorable Body, in order to give justice and fairness to every individual citizen, advise Mr. Usualdo F. Laguitan of his violation of the provisions of Resolution Numbered 86, s. 1951 and to advise him said resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Guillermo Parrilla seconded by Councilor Teodoro Tan;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to request the Bureau of Lands, Manila that portion of public land which was granted to Mr. Usualdo F. Laguitan, adjoining Lots Nos. 1237 and 1239 by virtue of a revocable permit be no longer extended in his favor;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that portion of land as above stated be no longer extended in his favor on the ground that the city government has reserved the whole portion of that public land for public improvement;

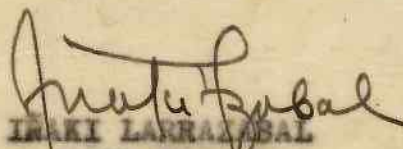
