RESOLUTION NO. 73

WHEREAS, the Municipal Board of this City is conscious of the fact that so many incendiaries have occurred in Ormog City were due to faulty electrical wiring;

WHEREAS, there have been more than five incendiaries in a space of one year, the last one occurred on October 4, 1952, where the big portion of the City's business district was wiped out;

WHEREAS, after due investigation made by this Board through a Committee appointed by same, it was found that most residential and business houses, be they of strong or light materials, have faulty electrical wiring;

WHEREAS, the faulty electrical wiring found in many houses were due to illegal connections made and allowed to be made by owners themselves and which the Ormog Electric Company have no right nor authority to stop and check;

WHEREAS, in view of the conditions existing and enumerated in the foregoing paragraphs as regards electrical connections, wiring, etc., in many residential and business houses in Ormog City, the present Municipal Board of Ormog City has passed Resolution No. 166, Series of 1952 called the Electrical Ordinance, with the end in view of putting remedies, corrections, and to improve said situations and conditions and thus prevent and avoid the occurrence of further fires and incendiaries;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Board finds it imperative that in the proper implementation and enforcement of said Electrical Ordinance as embodied in said Resolution No. 166 Series of 1952 to create the position of an Electrical Inspector, whose duty it is to inspect, report on electrical connections, supervise, and recommend measures as he deems proper for the safety of all concerned;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Alvaro I. Gutierrez, seconded by Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to create the position of an Electrical Inspector for Ormoc City with a salary of P1,800.00 per annum;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the amount of P1,800.00 appropriated for the salary of the Electrical Inspector be taken from the General Fund of this City;


RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that said Electrical Inspector be under the direct supervision of the City Engineer of Ormoc City;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to respectfully request the higher authorities concerned in Manila, thru the City Engineer, Ormoc City, to expedite the appointment of the same in view of the urgency of this measure;


