RESOLUTION NO. 81

WHEREAS, the Municipal Board of Ormoc City in its Special Session held on May 13, 1953 passed Resolution No. 39 requesting the higher authorities concerned in Manila that the salaries of intermediate teachers in the City of Ormoc be borne by the National Government in view of the precarious financial condition of the City Government of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Mr. Benito Pafigilinan, Director of the Bureau of Public Schools in his official communication dated July 10, 1953, informed the Secretary to the Board that his department is not in a position to recommend approval of the request made in the aforementioned Resolution for the reason that no appropriations have been included in the budget for the Bureau of Public Schools for the fiscal year 1954 and for further reason that the intermediate classes in Chartered Cities will be financed by the City government in accordance with the provision of Section 7 of Commonwealth Act No. 586;

WHEREAS, Councilor Victorino C. Teleron strongly suggested to the Honorable Body to respectfully request Hon. Domingo Veloso, Speaker Protempore, House of Representatives, Manila to recommend legislation in Philippine Congress to amend the Educational Act of 1941 otherwise known as Commonwealth Act No. 586, to the effect that the salaries of City Intermediate grades be borne by the National Government;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Victorino C. Teleron seconded by Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to respectfully request Hon. Domingo Veloso, Speaker Protempore, House of Representatives, Manila to recommend legislation in Philippine Congress to amend the Educational Act of 1941 otherwise known as Commonwealth Act No. 586;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to respectfully convey to Congressman Domingo Veloso the necessity of amending said Commonwealth Act No. 586 for the reason that the amount to be allocated for the salaries of the intermediate teachers

could be utilized in the readjustment of salaries for the city officials and employees as provided for by Republic Act 840 and the implementation of the minimum wage law of the city employees;
