RESOLUTION NO. 56

WHEREAS, Mr. Protasio Escobro, City Agronomist, Ormoc City, in his letter, dated February 23, 1954, requested that he be authorized by the Municipal Board, Ormoc City, to use the perishable products of the city nursery, such as camote, cassava, bananas and coconuts as feeds for the hogs; and to sell the pigs produced in the city nursery based on the verbal suggestion of Dr. Anastacio Tolentino, District Veterinarian, as follows:

1. Pure-breed berkshire, male or female, 3 mos. old - P25.00 to P35.00 each; and
2. Cross-breed berkshire, male or female, 3 mos. old - P15.00 to P25.00 each; and

that the proceeds of the sale of these pigs be used as a revolving fund in the production of hogs to purchase other feeds such as fish meal, corn and rice bran, copra meal and molasses and other materials for housing and fencing facilities and for medicine;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Emilio C. Penserga, seconded by Councilor Usualdo F. Laguitan and Councilor Teotimo Ocubillo;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to authorize the City Agronomist, Ormoc City to use the perishable products of the city nursery, such as camote, cassava, bananas and coconuts as feeds for the hogs in said nursery and that he be authorized to sell the pigs produced in the city nursery based on the verbal suggestion of Dr. Anastacio Tolentino, District Veterinarian, as follows:

1. Pure-breed berkshire, male or female, 3 mos. old, P25.00 to P35.00 each, and
2. Cross-breed berkshire, male or female, 3 mos. old, P15.00 to P25.00 each,

provided there is already a sufficient number of pigs to be sold;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proceeds of the sale of these pigs be utilized as a revolving fund in the production of hogs, to purchase other feeds, such as, fish meal, corn and rice bran, copra meal and molasses and other materials for housing and fencing facilities, and for medicine;
