victims;


NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, that the former
occupants of the stalls of the market tiendas that was burned
be allowed to return to their respective stalls in the newly
constructed market tiendas; Provided, they will pay first
their back accounts, if any, and that if they do not return,
their stalls may be occupied by other persons, only through
proper public bidding, with the provisions of Ordinance No.
5, adopted in Resolution No. 46, series 1951 as a minimum
requirement;

and the Market Superintendent, all of Ormoc City.
