Executive Secretary, Malacañang, Manila; The President, Provincial Governors and City Mayors League, Manila; the Senate President, Manila; the Speaker, House of Representatives, Manila; Congressmen of the five districts of Leyte; the Provincial Covernor, Tacloban City; and all the Municipal cial Governor, Tacloban City; and all the Municipal Councils of the Province of Leyte.
