RESOLUTION NO. 80

WHEREAS, the Chronicle published on the April 29th
issue Presidential appointments, one of whom is Attorney
Teodulo Tandayag as Vice-Mayor of Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, Atty. Tandayag is from Pintuyan, Leyte, a
distance of around 300 kilometers from Ormoc City and
that he is not fully acquainted on the problems of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, there are many people in this City who are
fully qualified for the position from the Nacionalista
Party or from all other political parties;

WHEREAS, we believe that the Vice-Mayor and Mayor
should be from Ormoc City;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor
Usualdo F. Laguitan, seconded by Councilor Esteban C. Conejos;


BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to protest on
the appointment of Atty. Teodulo Tandayag as Vice-Mayor of
Ormoc City and to respectfully request His Excellency, the
President of the Philippines to appoint a Mayor and a Vice-
Mayor from among the residents of Ormoc City;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to send through telegram the contents
hereof, to His Excellency, the President of the Philippines,
Malacañang, Manila;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution
each to His Excellency, the President of the Philippines,
Malacañang, Manila; the Hon. City Mayor; City Treasurer
and the City Auditor, all of Ormoc City.
