RESOLUTION NO. 34

WHEREAS, be it known that Section 2, Ordinance No. 5, adopted in Resolution No. 46, series of 1951 provides: that "I" stalls facing Real street are for dry goods"; and that the "I" stalls facing invards, according to the Market Superintendent, cannot be occupied by sari-sari stores neither dry goods operators because that is preferred for dried and salted fish;

WHEREAS, Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla expressed opinion that it would be more profitable for the City Government it the "X" stalls facing inwards will be occupied by either sari-sari stores or dried and salted fish operators.

NOW TAXABLE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Teotimo Ocubillo;

BY FI RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to amend Section 2. Ordinance No. 5, Resolution No. 46, series of 1951 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2.-ZONIFICATION:-(a) "I" stalls facing Real Street are for dry goods and "I" stalls facing inwards should be for either sari-sari stores or for dried and salted fish."

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the Hon. City Mayor; City Treasurer; City Auditor; and the Market Superintendent, all of Ormoc City.
