RESOLUTION NO. 89

Letter of the Chief of Police, Ormoc City, dated Mar.  
15, 1954, addressed to the Hon. Municipal Board, thru His  
Honor, the City Mayor, Ormoc City, hereunder quoted verba-  
tim as follows:

S i r :

On 31st December 1953, Cpl. Ulpiano Calderon and Det.  
Andres Laureñana, all members of the Ormoc City Police  
Department, were sent to Cebu City and nearby towns to  
follow up and apprehend if found one Victor Arcuino, who  
was charged of Slight Physical Injuries in Criminal Case  
No. 3348.

While in the performance of their official mission in  
Cebu, Cpl. Ulpiano Calderon was attacked of a severe sto-  
mach trouble, thus causing him to return to station and  
reported his sickness, in which case he was advised to  
consult the doctor. On January 11, 1954, he was hospi-  
talized and operated of Apendectomy by Dr. Alvaro Gutierrez.

It is therefore requested that Cpl. Ulpiano Calderon, who  
contacted his illness in line of duty, be helped financial-  
ly to enable him to pay his obligations to the hospital.

Cpl. Ulpiano Calderon is a poor-married man with a big  
family and is the only source of their daily bread. Up to  
the present, Cpl. Ulpiano Calderon is still weak due to  
his operation and yet because of necessity and poverty,  
he is still in hot pursuit of a job to make both ends meet.

WHEREAS, Councilor Esteban C. Conejos strongly suggested to the Hon. Members of the Board to appropriate the amount of ₱237.00 to pay the expenses of the operation and hospitalization of Cpl. Ulpiano Calderon, he having contacted illness while in the performance of his official duties as Member of the Police Force of Ormoc City;


NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Esteban C. Conejos, seconded by Councilor Jorge S. Tan;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to appropriate the amount of ₱237.00 from funds not otherwise appropriated to pay the expenses of Cpl. Ulpiano Calderon while he was operated and hospitalized in the Sacred Heart Hospital, Ormoc City, the illness having been contacted while in the performance of his official duties;




