RESOLUTION NO. 108

WHEREAS, a communication has been received from higher military authorities advising the Chief of Police of Ormoc City that long arms loaned to the Police Department will be withdrawn;

WHEREAS, as per information of the Chief of Police, subject long arms to be withdrawn will cost the City Government more or less P3,000.00;

WHEREAS, in the absence of arms, the Police Department will be hampered in the protection of lives and properties of the citizens of Ormoc City;


NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Cleto P. Evangelista, seconded by Councilor Usualdo F. Laguitan;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to most respectfully request the Chief of Staff, GHQ, Armed Forces of the Philippines, Camp Murphy, Quezon City, to extend the period for the Ormoc City Police Department to use the long arms until such time when Ormoc City will be financially sound to acquire firearms;


RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the Chief of Staff, GHQ, AFP, Camp Murphy, Quezon City; the Hon. City Mayor; City Treasurer; City Auditor and the CO, 59th PC Company, Camp Downes, Ormoc City.
