NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Usualdo F. Laguitan, seconded by Vice Mayor Rafael M. Mejia;


BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to indorse the stand of President Ramon Magsaysay of the Philippines on the Formosa question;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the approval of this resolution be made known to the President of the Philippines by telegram;



CARRIED. 5 in favor. Councilors Parrilla, Conejos and Ocubillo against.


