WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc is not yet in the state of paying these accrued vacation & sick leaves in view of its precarious financial condition;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Teotimo Ocubillo seconded by Councilor Esteban Conejos;


