RESOLUTION NO. 39-A

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COUNCILOR ALVARO I GUTIERREZ
OF ORMOC CITY TO APPEAR FOR, SPEAK AND MAKE REPRESENTATIONS IN BEHLF OF THE MUNICIPAL BOARD OF ORMOC CITY
TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES TO VIGOROUSLY OPPOSE HOUSE
BILL NO. 4832, A RILL CREATING THE MUNICIPALITY OF
VALENCIA IN THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE

WHEREAS Congressman Domingo Veloso of the second district of Leyte, has introduced House Bill No. 4832, creating the municipality of Valencia in the Province of Leyte, which if approved will separate the barrios of Valencia, Wasunogan, Catayum, Catmon, Balion, Cabulhan, Cagbuhangin, Hibunaon, San Jose, Sabang Bao, Picoy, Mas-in, Manlilinao, Monterico, Maticaa, Masarayao, San Ignatio and Nueva Vista from the City of Ormoc;

WNEXAS, the Municipal Board of Ormoc fully know that the intention of the bill presented by the aforementioned Congressman is not to help the people of said barrios that are to comprise the municipality of Valencia but to cripple Ormoc City both financially and economically;

WHEREAS, Congressman Domingo Veloso, the very author of Republic Act 179, otherwise known as the Charter creating the City of Ormoc, in 1947, had since that time made so many moves and had presented Bills slicing the territory of the City of Ormoc as created by Republic Act 179, to mention one is that Republic Act creating the municipality of Kananga, Leyte, which composed of former barrio Kananga of Ormoc City together with so many adjoining former barrios of Ormoc City, and again in his House Bill creating the municipality of Tugbong from the territory of the municipality of Kananga, Leyte and some barrios of Ormoc City, which House Bill did not prosper;

WHEREAS, the people of the City of Ormoc has reason to be intrigued by the motives of Congressman Domingo Veloso in presenting said Bill No. 4832, because out of the many towns comprising the Second Congressional District of Leyte which he represents he always focus his attention to Ormoc City as much as he can;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Teotimo P. Ocubillo, seconded by Councilor Esteban C. Conejos;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to authorize Councilor Alvaro I. Gutierrez as he is hereby authorized to appear, speak and make representations in behalf of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, to the House of Representatives and the Senate, Congress of the Philippines, to vigorously oppose House Dill No. 4832, presented by Congressman Domingo Velosc of the second district of Leyte, creating the Municipality of Valencia in the Province of Leyte.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish copies of this heso-lution each to His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, Malacañang, Manila, the Honorable Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Honorable Speaker Protempore of the House of Representatives, the Chairman of the House Committee on Chartered Cities, the Chairman of the House Committee on Provincial and Municipal Governments, all of Manila; the Honorable President of the Senate, the Honorable President Protempore of the Senate, the Chairman of the Senate Committee on Local Governments, all of Manila; the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer and the City Auditor, all of Ormo: City UNANDOUSLY.
