RESOLUTION NO. 79

Letter of the Fertilizer Supervisor, Ormoc City,
dated February 10, 1956, quoted verbatim hereunder,
as follows:

"Republic of the Philippines
"Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources
"Office of the Secretary
"FERTILIZER ADMINISTRATION
"Ormoc City

"February 10, 1956

"The Honorable City Council
Thru Honorable City Mayor
Ormoc City, Leyte

"Gentlemen:

"Whereas, the Fertilizer Administration, under the
Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources, had
done a great help to implement the President's Program
of Rural Improvement by increasing the farmers produc-
tion from 30% to 100% or from 30 cavans to 100 cavans
per hectare, especially rice and corn; and

"Whereas, House Bill No. 4652 is now in the hands
of Congress creating the Bureau of Fertilizers in order
to maintain helps to small farmers.

"Therefore, I have the honor to request, as it is
hereby requested, that august body to pass a resolution
requesting the president and members of Congress of both
Houses to approve House Bill No. 4652, creating the Bu-
reau of Fertilizers in order to help the plight of small
farmers.

"Requesting Further, that copies of the resolution
be furnished the President of the Philippines; the Presi-
dent and President-Protempore of the Senate; the Speaker
and Speaker Protempore of the House of Representatives;
the Floor-Leaders of both Houses of Congress and the
Representatives of Leyte and the Secretary of Agriculture
and Natural Resources, for their immediate help and con-
sideration.




