## RESOLUTION NO. 79

Letter of the Fertilizer Supervisor, Ormoc City, dated February 10, 1956, quoted verbatim hereunder, as follows:

"Centlemen:

"Whereas, the Fertilizer Administration, under the Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources, had done a great help to implement the President's Program of Rural Improvement by increasing the farmers production from 30% to 100% or from 30 cavans to 100 cavans per hectare, especially rice and corn; and

"Whereas, House Bill No. 4652 is now in the hands of Congress creating the Bureau of Fertilizers in offder to maintain helps to small farmers.

"Therefore, I have the honor to request, as it is hereby requested, that august body to pass a resolution requesting the president and members of Congress of both Houses to approve House Bill No. 4652, creating the Bureau of Fertilizers in order to help the plight of small farmers.

"Requesting Further, that copies of the resolution be furnished the President of the Philippines; the President and President-Protempore of the Senate; the Speaker and Speaker Protempore of the House of Representatives; the Floor-Leaders of both Houses of Congress and the Representatives of Leyte and the Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources, for their immediate help and consideration.

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to indorse favorably the foregoing letter of the Jr. Fertilizer Supervisor of Ormoc City, and to request the officials mentioned in the above-quoted letter to approve House Bill No. 4652, creating the Bureau of Fertilizers in order to help the plight of small farmers.

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Resolution each to the Honorable Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Speaker Frotemore of the House of Representatives, the President and President Pro-Tempore of the Senate, Congress of the Philippines, all of Manila; His Excellency, President Ramon Magsaysay, Malacañang, Manila; the five congressmen of Layte; the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Jr. Fertilizer Supervisor, all of Ornoc City.
