RESOLUTION NO. 92

"WHEREAS, this Board passed Resolution No. 65 on March 17, 1956, calling the attention of the Ormoc Electric Company, Inc. of the poor service they are giving to the people of Ormoc City;

"WHEREAS, in said Resolution No. 65, this Board manifested the low voltage (160) which the Ormoc Electric Company is giving its consumers instead of the 220 volts which they are supposed to power their lines;

"WHEREAS, in answer to said Resolution No. 65, current series, the Company answered that the cause of the poor service they are giving the people of Ormoc City is due to a broken crankshaft on their main engine, whose parts can not be obtained locally;

"WHEREAS, it has been three months already that the people of Ormoc City had been suffering untold damages in their electric installations due to inefficient, although costly service;

"WHEREAS, the people of Ormoc City had been very much prejudiced on this poor service;

"WHEREAS, The Company is still charging the people of Ormoc City the usual charge of ₱0.40 per kilowatt which is one among the few if not the most exorbitant rate charged for electric consumption throughout the country;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Iñaki Larrazabal, seconded by Councilors Jorge P. Tan, Jr., Cesar Samson and Alvaro I. Gutierrez;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to request as this Body hereby respectfully requests His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, to intervene in this plight of the people of Ormoc City for a better electric lighting service, so as to relieve them of their sufferings of untold damages due to inefficient service, and so that the people may be kept away from its harmful effects, and that the company be ordered to restore to its lines the correct and exact voltage which they are supposed to give to the people, which is 220 volts;
