RESOLUTION NO. 110

"WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc is in receipt of her share from the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes draw held on March 18, 1956 in the amount of ₱168.85 as covered by Check No. PC-01433;

"WHEREAS, as provided by law, this share may be allotted by the Municipal Board for maintenance of city health, social welfare and charitable work based upon the recommendation of the chief of the health department;

"WHEREAS, the City Health Officer, in a 2nd indorsement dated June 7, 1956 recommended that this amount of ₱168.85 be allotted as follows:

₱100 - for the purchase of emergency medicines
68.85 - for repair of the dispensary building

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to appropriate the share of Ormoc City from the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes draw of March 18, 1956 in the amount of ₱168.85 covered by Check No. PC-01433, as follows:

₱100 - for the purchase of emergency medicines
68.85 - for repairs of the dispensary building;
