RESOLUTION NO. 147

"WHEREAS, there are a number of newly appointed policemen in the City of Ormoc;

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to authorize the City Treasurer to pay the salaries of newly appointed policemen from the savings of the Police Department;

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Resolution each to the Honorable City Mayor, City Treasurer, City Auditor and Chief of Police, all of Ormoc City.
