"WHEREAS, this Body received a set of communications the original or basic of which is a radiogram from the Philippine Constabulary at Davao City informing the Municipal Judge at Ormoc City that one, Alfonso Cit, who is being charged in the Municipal Court of Ormoc City for Grave Threats is rearrested in Davao on account of the bondsmen's withdrawal of their bonds for his provisional liberty;

"WHEREAS, as stated in said radiogram from the PC, the PC Command at Davao City has no fund to defray transportation expanses of prisoners and also lacks troops to conduct prizoners, and at the same time, requesting that a policeman from Ormoc City be sent to Davao to pick up said prisoner;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to appropriate the amount of \$120.00 from Yout of any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be made available for the transportation and subsistence expenses of a policeman from Ormoc City to Davao City to pick up and escort a prisoner at Davao to Ormoc City.

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Resolution each to the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Chief of Police, all of Ormoc City. CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
