RESOLUTION NO. 195

Resolution No. 426, current series, of the Municipal Council of the Provincial Capital of Surigao, Surigao, requesting His Excellency, President Ramon Magsaysay, to order the elimination from the forthcoming General Clerical Civil Service Examinations the National Language (Tagalog) in non-Tagalog regions of the Philippines, to enable the non-Tagalog speaking Filipinos to have the same chance in gaining admission or retention in the Civil Service, was presented.

"WHEREAS, this Body believes that with the illogical and selfish inclusion of the Tagalog subject in the forthcoming General Clerical examinations, the non-Tagalog speaking Filipinos are being discriminated and robbed of their chances of passing said examinations;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Esteban C. Conejos, seconded by Councilor Emilio C. Penserga;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to concur in and adhere with, as this Body hereby concurs in and adheres with, the embodiments of Resolution No. 426, current series, of the Municipal Council of the Provincial Capital of Surigao, Surigao, and to request further as this Body requests, His Excellency, President Ramon Magsaysay, to order or cause to be eliminated from the forthcoming civil service examinations (General Clerical), in the non-Tagalog regions of the Philippines, the Tagalog subject, so as to enable the non-Tagalog speaking Filipinos to have the same chance in gaining admission or retention in the Civil Service with those of the Tagalogs themselves;

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Resolution each to His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, Malacanang, Manila; the Honorable Commissioner of Civil Service, Manila; the Municipal Secretary, Surigao, Surigao; the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer and the City Auditor, all of Ormoc City.
