"WHEREAS, as per information in a 5th indorsement dated December 3, 1956 of the Deputy Commissioner of the Budget, an allotment of ₱1,380 has been released November 16, 1956 from the Contingent Fund for the repair of the damages caused by flood on the grouted riprap dike on the concrete wall along the southern bank of the Malbasag River, Ormoc City;

"WHEREAS, the repair of the dike above mentioned will safeguard lives, properties and the public highway which floods occurring now and then are threatening to damage;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."


