RESOLUTION NO. 218

"WHEREAS, Vice Mayor Mejia informed the Board that in his conversation with Division Superintendent of Schools Sancho Paulino, the Superintendent said he would recommend the closing of the City High School if the city can not comply with the requirements of the Bureau of Public Schools as regards the school site and plant of a public high school;

"WHEREAS, at present Ormoc City can not possibly afford to comply with the requisites of the Bureau of Public Schools in view of its precarious financial situation;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Vice Mayor Rafael M. Mejia, seconded by Councilor Teotimo P. Ocubillo;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to request as this Body hereby requests Honorable Domingo Veloso, Congressman for the Second District of Leyte, to give Ormoc City an aid in the amount of ₱20,000 from whatever source he may be able to procure for the Ormoc City High School plant;



"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."


