RESOLUTION NO. 37

"WHEREAS, in a letter to this Board dated March 7, 1957, the City Engineer, this city, informed that the opening of bids for the construction of the proposed market buildings is on March 25, 1957;

"WHEREAS, in the same letter the City Engineer requested that the buildings site be cleared before the opening of bids so that prospective bidders may have a clear idea of the nature of work to be undertaken, particularly the volume of filling materials;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla, seconded by Teotimo P. Ocubillo;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that in order not to prejudice the general public and adversely affect the government revenue, a portion of Rizal Street be, as it is hereby, closed to vehicular traffic from the corner at C. Aviles St. to the corner of Lopez Jaena St., and that the same be designated as a temporary market place/site for those stall holders affected by the forthcoming construction;

"RESOLVED FURTHER, that the transfer of these stall holders to the closed portion of Rizal St. be supervised by the Market Superintendent in order to avoid unnecessary congestion and blocking of those stores along the same street;

"RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that this Resolution take effect as of the date of approval by the City Mayor of Ormoc;

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Resolution each to the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer, the City Auditor, the Chief of Police, the City Health Officer and the Market Superintendent, all of Ormoc City.

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."


