

"BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, to forward the original of this Resolution to His Excellency, President Carlos P. Garcia, Malacañang, Manila;


"BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish a copy of this Resolution to His Honor, the City Mayor, Ormoc City.

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."


