Sir:

Pursuant to the provision of Section 693 of the Revised Manual of Instructions to Treasurers, 1954 edition, I have the honor to inform His Honor, that the following named-employees have been paid and or with leaves due them accumulated for services rendered as follows:

1. Mr. Vicente Bartiquin, 45 days, from April 2 to May 16, 1957, inclusive .....P180.00 paid already,
2. Mr. Margarito Matres, 46 days, from April 3 to May 18, 1957, inclusive .....P181.68 paid already, and
3. Atty. Antonio Sumaljag, 20 days, from April 1 to 20, 1957, have not yet been paid, with a money value of P126.67.


"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Emilio C. Penserga, seconded by Councilor Teotimo P. Ocubillo;


