RESOLUTION NO. 122

Letter of the City Auditor, Ormoc City, dated June 27, 1957,
quoted verbatim hereunder, reads as follows:

Gentlemen:

I have the honor to request that the sum of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) be appropriated in item C-3-f for the necessary traveling expenses and per diems of Assistant Auditor Monico P. Amihan, during this fiscal year while on detail in this City vice Asst. Auditor Daciano Palami. Mr. Amihan was designated Acting Assistant Auditor of this Office at the rate of One Hundred Fifty Pesos (P150.00) only per month payable by the National Fund. He was already receiving this rate of compensation when he was yet in Baybay National Agricultural School. In view of his transfer to this City, consequent to the abolition of Mr. Palami's position, Mr. Amihan suffered considerable losses particularly in his financial condition. He has abandoned his own house and home industries as poultry raising and home garden besides the fact that he pays rental for his residence and light as well as water service in this City.

Under auditing requirements and regulation, Mr. Amihan may be reimbursed of his traveling expenses including per diems fixed under the rate of salary (Executive Order No. 131, dated Sept. 23, 1955) provided that duly approved appropriation and fund therefor are available. In justice and fairness to Mr. Amihan for he is a family man with six dependents, this request has been made in order to ameliorate his meager income.

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."


