## RESOLUTION NO. 124

in Ormoc City, filed a claim with this Board for disability pay by virtue of the provision of Sec. 1-(b), Republic Act No. 784, for being disabled (attacked with paralysis) while on post as trafficman on October 26, 1955; "WHEREAS, Mr. Edilberto Jamile, an ex-policeman

WHERMAS Wr. Jamile's claim was indorsed by this Body to the Office of the City Attorney for his legal opinion on the said claim, as to whether as a city police-man Mr. Namile is entitled to the benefits afforded in the above-mentioned Act;

"WALER CAS, the City Attorney, in an Opinion numbered VII contained in a 4th indorsement dated July 8, 1957, ruled that Mr. Jamile's claim for disability pay does not come within the purview of Republic Act 784 and therefore, should be denied;

"WHEREAS, Councilor Parrilla manifested before this Body that since Mr. Jamile's claim can not be granted under the provisions of Republic Act 784, his case may still be allowed under Section 699 of the Revised Administrative Code;

"WHEREAS, Councilor Du, upon learning of the citation of Councilor Parrilla and taking advantage of the presence of the City Attorney in the session hall, moved to ask for the opinion of the City Attorney on the applicability of Section 699 of the Revised Administrative Code to the case of Mr. Jamile; and

"WHEREAS, the City Attorney rendered his opinion before this Board in session that said Section 699 of the Revised Administrative Code can apply to the case of Mr. Jamile;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Emilio C. Penserga;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to appropriate the amount of P480 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be made available for the payment of allowance for disability of Mr. Edilberto Jamile, from any funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated, hereby authorizing the City Treasurer, to pay Mr. Jamile this allowance minus all money already advanced to him in the form of sick and vaccition leave and all other allowances p aid to him not as salary for services rendered actually;

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED FURTHER, that this amount be certified to as an outstanding obligation for inclusion in the annual budget of Ormoc City for the fiscal year 1957-58 under the Police Department;

"BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Resolution be furnished each the Hon. 6ity Mayor, the City Treasurer, the City Auditor, the Chief of Police and Mr. Edilberto Jamile, all of Ormos City.

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."
