RESOLUTION NO. 232

"WHEREAS, Councilor Marciano S. Du has informed the Municipal Board that a pre-fabricated school building has been shipped to Barrio San Jose of this City;

"WHEREAS, an amount of Two Hundred Pesos would be needed to erect the pre-fabricated school building for San Jose taking into account other materials as well as labor for the completion of the same;

"WHEREAS, Councilor Marciano S. Du has suggested to revert the amount of Two Hundred Pesos from out of the Discretionary Fund of the Office of the City Mayor;


"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Marciano S. Du, seconded by Councilors Jorge P. Tan, Jr. and Teotimo P. Ocubillo;

"BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to revert the amount of TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00) from out of the Discretionary Fund of the Office of the City Mayor to be made available for the erection of the pre-fabricated school building for Barrio San Jose of this City;


"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the Honorable City Mayor, the City Treasurer, the City Auditor, the District Supervisor of Ormoc II, the Principal and the Barrio Lieutenant of San Jose, all of Ormoc City; and the Division Superintendent of Schools for Leyte, Tacloban City.


