WHEREAS, in a letter to this Board dated Nevember 11, 1957, the Department of Finance, Manila, thru the Nonorable Undersected are proposed to be created in the current annual budget for the general fund of the city government of Ormoc;

"WHEREAS, the Name letter mentioned above stated that the appropriations for the creation of positions should be reverted to the mappropriated account and reappropriated for the restoration of the abolished positions;

"WHERE'S, in a series of indorsements relative to the matter, the City Treasurer and this Body had the same idea to refer the said letter to the Office of the City Attorney for coment and opinion of the legal angle as pertains the abolished positions;

"MHEREAS, in a 4th indorsement dated January 15, 1958, the City Actorney maintained that the creation and abolition of positions are the prerogatives and authority properly belonging to the legislative branch and the executive branch of the government;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Gutierrez, seconded by Councilors Du and Larrazabal;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to request the Honorable Secretary of Finance, Manila, to reconsider his decision embodied in a letter to this Board dated December 11, 1957, and that the following positions proposed to be created which this Board considers to be very essential be approved:

Three Market Collectors at \$\mathbb{P}60 per annum each;
One Stenographer at \$\mathbb{P}1200 per annum, City Attorney's Office;
One Janitor-Messenger at \$\mathbb{P}960 per annum, City Library;
One Agricultural Adviser and Fertilizer In-charge at
\$\mathbb{P}1440 per annum, Office of the City Mayor;}

"RESOLVED FURTHER, to forward the opinion of the City Attorney of Ormoc City embodied in a 4th indorsement dated January 15, 1958, to the Honorable Secretary of Finance, Manila, for consideration;

"RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, to inform the Honorable Secretary of Finance that this request for consideration has been made in view of the necessity of these positions and on the strength of the aforementioned 4th indorsement of the City Attorney.

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to Congressman Dominador M. Tan of the 2nd District of Leyte, House of Representatives, Manila; the Honorable Executive Secretary, Manila; the City Treasurer and the City Auditor, both of Ormoc City.
