RESOLUTION NO. 29

"WHEREAS, in barrio San Vicente, this City, there is a creek which is crossed by the Ormoc-San Vicente road and which up to this time, has no bridge across;

"WHEREAS, there is also another/creek between barrios Libertad and Lao which also needs a bridge in order to ease transportation between these barrios and the city;

"WHEREAS, this board deems it necessary to have bridges across the creeks above mentioned constructed, for the benefit of the public in general;


"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Penserga, seconded by Councilor Parrilla;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to request the City Engineer, Ormoc City, to furnish at least second-hand lumber and materials for the construction of a temporary or provisional bridge across the Pongot Creek in barrio San Vicente and another one across the Lao River between Libertad and Lao;


"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the City Engineer, the City Treasurer, the City Auditor, the Barrio Lieutenants of Law and San Vicente, all of Ormoc City.

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."


