RESOLUTION NO. 95

"WHEREAS, barrio Lao, Ormoc City, is one barrio that badly needs a decent school building to house its school children;

"WHEREAS, there is at present in the said barrio, a temporary nipa building whose roofs are badly leaking and its walls about to rot;

"WHEREAS, the barrio people of Lao have filed a petition with this Board, requesting assistance in securing an aid for the repair of their school building, or if possible, the replacement of same with a semi-permanent one; and

"WHEREAS, the operation of the primary classes in barrio Lao is directly the concern of the national government;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Gutierrez, seconded by Councilor Parrilla;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to request Congressman Dominador M. Tan of the 2nd District of Leyte, House of Representatives, Manila, to spare the amount of P2,500.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary from out of his Pork Barrel Fund, for the construction of a semi-permanent school building for barrio Lao, Ormoc City;


"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish a copy of this resolution to the Barrio Lieutenant of Lao, Ormoc City.

"CARRIED, Unanimously."


