RESOLUTION NO. 113

"WHEREAS, this Board, in its regular session held on July 11, 1958, passed Resolution No. 104 appropriating P70.00 for the purchase of steel cables or galvanized wires for the use of barrios Pikoy and Manlilinao and for the purposes stated therein i.e., to serve as a line to hold bancas ferrying people across the Pagsanga-an River; and

"WHEREAS, after the purchases were made, it was found out that the said wires were insufficient, and still need G.I. rings;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Gutierrez;


"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to amend Resolution No. 104, c.s., so that the amount appropriated therein be made P137.00 instead of only P70.00, to be made available for the same purpose for which the original appropriation has been made;

"RESOLVED FURTHER, to incorporate the sum of P137.00 in the current annual budget for this purpose;


"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the City Treasurer, the City Auditor and the Barrio Lieutenant of Pikoy, all of Ormoc City.

"CARRIED, Unanimously."


