RESOLUTION NO. 139

"WHEREAS, the probable income of Ormoc City for the fiscal year 1958-1959 which the City Treasurer submitted to the Office of the City Mayor is the sum of Three Hundred Ninety Thousand Three Hundred Ten Pesos (P390,210.00), and the City Mayor pursuant to Section 9(1), Article II of Republic Act 179 as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, in turn submitted to the Municipal Board an estimated income in conformity with the estimate of the City Treasurer to be made the basis of the estimate of the expenditures for the said fiscal year 1958-1959;

"WHEREAS, the Municipal Board after having effected a program of economy in the previous budgets by temporarily abolishing some positions and minimizing contingent expenses, may no longer incur over draft in the funds of some departments including the Intermediate School Fund where back salaries have now been fully paid and monthly salaries implemented in accordance with the educational qualifications of the teachers;

"WHEREAS, the Municipal Board, in consonance with Republic Act 840 standardizing the salaries of City officials according to classification of the cities to which they respectively belong has effected in this budget a raise in their salaries and, in line with its general policy to implement the Minimum Wage Law which affect the greatest bulk of the city employees, has effected increases and, in meritorious cases, has effected full implementation of the law, to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE NECESSARY EXPENSES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOG DURING THE PERIOD FROM JULY 1, 1958 TO JUNE 30, 1959, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179 as amended by Republic Act 429, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of FIVE HUNDRED NINETY THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED TEN PESOS AND THIRTY TWO CENTAVOS (P593,710.32) or so much thereof as may be necessary are hereby appropriated to meet the operational expenses of the City Government of Ormoc City during the period from July 1, 1958 to June 30, 1959 for the various departments, branches or offices thereof subject to such limitations and manner as provided hereafter:

SECTION 2. All sums appropriated in this Ordinance for salaries and wages for the various departments and offices of the City Government shall be expended for the specific purposes for which they are appropriated and no amount appropriated for salaries and wages shall be available for the payment of contingent and other expenses or vice versa; Provided however, That by Resolution of the Municipal Board upon the approval of the City Mayor, the City Treasurer shall enter in the account books of the City Treasurer such transfer or readjustment of unexpended balances from one item to another in this appropriation Ordinance for the purposes of paying obligations which are expressly authorized by law.

SECTION 3. The total amount appropriated in this Ordinance for the contingent expenses of any department or office of the City Government shall be available for the specific authority of the Board to be done by Resolution duly approved by the City Mayor, for the payment of any or all items or contingent expenses pertinent to the said department or office; Provided However, That the respective appropriations herein made for the said department, or office for traveling expenses of personnel shall be available for payment of such expenses as may accrue to said department or office by reason of the operation of the Revised Administrative Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect as of the 1st day of July, Nineteen Hundred and Fifty-Eight, A.D., except new positions which shall take effect upon the approval of this budget by the Secretary of Finance.

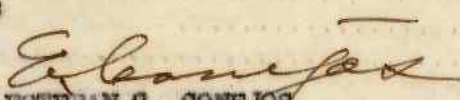

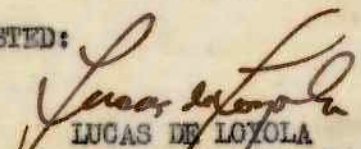
