"WHEREAS, in answer to said resolution, President Garcia wired this Body that he will give serious consideration to the request embodied in said resolution;

"WHEREAS, it is a fact and this Body is aware of it, that there is not a single Visayan holding a key position in the main office of the Bureau of Animal Industry in Manila to represent the Visayas; and

"WHEREAS, the only hope of the Visayas to be represented in the main office of the Bureau of Animal Industry is the person of Dr. Rosalio Mandin whose experience and knowledge in his field of work properly fits him to become Assistant Director of said bureau;


"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Samson, seconded by Councilor Gutierrez;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to reiterate the wishes of this Board as embodied in Resolution No. 131, c.s., hereby requesting again His Excellency, President Carlos P. Garcia to have Dr. Rosalio Mandin appointed as Assistant Director of the Bureau of Animal Industry, and requesting the President further, that Dr. Mandin's being a Boholano should not be a disqualification on his being appointed to the position;


