RESOLUTION NO. 203

"WHEREAS, with the arrival of the new fire engine sometime this coming January, 1959, Ormoc City will have two fire engines which this Board desires to station at separate places in the city;

"WHEREAS, the constructions of fire stations at strategic points in the city will mean an additional burden to the city coffers which at present is in a precarious financial condition; and

"WHEREAS, the only possibility of ever constructing the proposed fire stations is when the city receives an aid from the national government for the purpose in the form of Pork Barrel allocations from the Congressman's Pork Barrel Fund;


"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Tan, Jr., seconded by Councilor Du;

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to request Congressman Dominador M. Tan of the 2nd District of Leyte, now in Manila, to allocate from out of his coming Pork Barrel Fund the sum of Ten Thousand (P10,000) Pesos for the construction of two fire stations in Ormoc City;



"CARRIED, Unanimously."


