"MEN EVORE, the Roard, on motion of Councilor Parrilla, seconded by Councilor Gutierres;

"RESOLVAD, as it is hereby resolved, to request the Chief of the Constabulary, Care Crame, Quezon City, to authorize Ormoc City to purchase loose firearms for the use of the City Police Force;

"NEXOLVED FURTHER, to request the PC Chief that these loose Firearms purchased by the City should become the property of Ormoc Caty;

"RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the Chief of the Constabulary, Camp Crame, Quezon City; the Commanding General, III MA, Cebu City; the Provincial Commander, Camp Bumpus, Tacloban City; the Commanding Officer, 59th PC Co., Camp Downes, Ormoc City; the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; and the City Auditor, Ormoc City.
